The Calling

As many of you know, we have had the opportunity to travel to Guatemala to serve on three missions trips in Villa Nueva through Servants. Following our first trip in July, 2012, we felt a strong desire to become more involved in God's work in Guatemala, so we returned in January, 2013. Leading up to that trip we asked God to reveal to us how we could serve Him more in Guatemala. While in Guatemala in January, 2013 we felt God calling us to Guatemala as full time missionaries. We committed ourselves to prayer for two months before making any decisions. In March, we felt an even stronger calling to return to Guatemala as full time missionaries and we decided to pursue God's calling on our lives

further. We felt God leading us to serve Him in Guatemala with Servants, a local missions board with a strong commitment to seeing God's will accomplished in the United States and in Guatemala. When we returned to Guatemala in July, 2013 to serve with the Serving At Risk Families (also known as SARF) ministry through Servants, God opened our eyes and planted in us His vision for what He was calling us to. We had the opportunity to meet and work with several families currently being served by the SARF ministry. In addition to serving the spiritual and physical needs of the Guatemalan people through our involvement with the SARF ministry, God has called us to provide educational opportunities to low income at

risk families who otherwise may not have an opportunity to receive a proper education due to unaffordable costs of schooling in Guatemala. It is a long term goal of ours to start a Christian school to meet the needs of low income at risk children and families in Guatemala. God is also using our experiences with children's ministry and camps to develop organized children's ministry and camp programs in local churches and communities. We recently came across a quote that we feel speaks greatly of what God is doing through us in Guatemala. Otto Brunfels once said, "If one wants to reform the world and make it Christian, one must begin with children." We are excited to see how God will work out His calling on our lives in Guatemala!

Our Need

Not only are we trusting God to provide all of our needs financially, but we're also trusting God to raise up prayer partners to commit to faithfully praying for our ministry in Guatemala.
